The Murray Foundation is a UK registered Charity (No. 1162333) established to support young people participating in projects which advance education and develop an understanding of environmental processes. In line with this objective, the Murray Foundation has joined forces with Operation Wallacea to create the Murray Foundation School Award. Five awards of £1000 are available for five UK schools heading out to any Opwall expedition site in the Summer of 2019.

How to Apply

This is a **group application**; we want to hear about how are working together as a team to fundraise for your expedition. You may present this in any format you wish (previous examples include videos, slideshows, posters and poems), but please make it as captivating and creative as you can while covering the following areas:

1. Fundraising Team

- Introduce the members of your team and their fundraising roles
- What is your team name? (make it a good one - there may be bonus points!)

2. Fundraising Activities

- Tell us about each activity in as much detail as possible - from the planning stages to the main event
- Please provide a breakdown of how much each event raised and your final total

3. Photo Evidence

- Provide lots of photographs, and copies of any promotional materials you made (e.g. posters, flyers)
- Photos can be embedded in your application but please also send some high quality copies separately

4. Your Expedition

- Tell us, and the Murray Foundation, about your upcoming expedition
- Where are you going? What does the project entail? How will taking part benefit you?

5. £1000 Award

- If successful, how will you spend The Murray Foundation School Award?
- How will this enhance your expedition experience?
